Organization

Excellent School is running under Excellent Education Foundation ®, Kallabettu – Moodubidire since 2023. The school has classes from Kindergarten to Secondary level.

We should assist in this awakening process in the healthiest possible way, by bringing to the child the right kind of educational nourishment. This is what Excellent School aim at with sincerity in the best interests of the children and their future.

Aims & Objectives

The primary objectives of the Institution are-

1. To offer children a value-based and holistic education, which paves way for an integrated development of the physical, mental, intellectual and spiritual aspects of the personality, which is enriched by the knowledge of Indian culture and enhanced by patriotism and a universal outlook.
2. To give a practical and judicious combination of academic excellence, extra-curricular pursuits, character building and personality development.
3. To mould children into young men and women of moral strength who can face the challenges of modern life with a smile and make a difference in the world by their positive contribution.

General Information, Rules & Regulations

I. AFFILIATION :

Our school is affiliated to **Central Board of Secondary Education**, New Delhi.

II. SCHOOL CURRICULUM:

- a) **Kindergarten:** On the basis of NEP Curriculum, we have modified the KG syllabus. Retaining all good aspects of previous syllabus, we implemented more child-friendly method to enable the child to acquire the writing skill also at KG level. Further, in the new scheme, eligible kids can be directly admitted to UKG as well.

The kindergarten section has an exclusive play area, Giggle & Grow, for the kids. There is also a special skill-development park attached to it. Spacious play rooms, lunch hall etc are its attractions.

- b) **Primary and Secondary:** We have also adopted NEP curriculum proposed by CBSE for our all primary as well as secondary classes.
- c) **E-Learning with interactive board based on the latest technology is introduced from the academic year 2023-24 from LKG to X.**
- d) **The curriculum for classes I to IV includes :**
English, Kannada, Hindi, Mathematics, Environmental Studies, Computer Education, Art Education, Value Education, Physical Education, General Knowledge.

Extra –Curricular Activities

A number of extra-curricular activities has been introduced which are designed to develop the all-round personality of the students. Moral instruction, physical education, debate, music, dance, drawing and painting etc. are impacted to the students. Modern audio-visual room has already been in use. Computer training for all the students of Std. I to X is provided under Work Education Scheme. Science Club, Eco Club, Social Science/ Heritage Club, Mathematics Club, Literary Clubs are also functioning. Scouts/Guides, Cubs / Bulbuls & Bunnies are also actively functioning in the school.

III. Admissions and Withdrawals:

- Application forms duly filled in may be submitted on the stipulated date along with the **original birth certificate and a Xerox copy of it.**
- Students coming from other schools should bring their transfer certificates duly countersigned by the BEO /DDPI of the area. New Students must be introduced personally by their parents/guardians who will be responsible for their regularity of attendance and payment of dues.
- Right of admission is reserved with the Management and the decision of the Management in this regard is final.
- Admission to the higher classes is subject to availability of seats, performance in the assessment and production of T.C. duly countersigned by the educational officer concerned. TCs produced from foreign countries must be countersigned by the Indian Embassy of the country concerned.

Age limit of admission process:

Only those who have completed

- 4 years by June 1st of the respective calendar year are allotted admission for LKG.
- 5 years by June 1st of the respective calendar year for UKG.
- Those children who completed 6 years by 1st June in the respective calendar year will be admitted for class 1st.
- Original Birth Certificate issued by a competent authority and Aadhar Card is essential for admission. (**NOTE:** Birth certificate details should match with Aadhar card details).
- Transfer Certificate will be given only on the basis of a written application in the prescribed form, (available at the school office) to be submitted at least a week in advance by the parent/guardian.
- If a letter regarding the urgency is produced from the school where the student is seeking admission, Transfer Certificate will be issued on the third day of application.
- Transfer Certificate will be issued only to those who have fully settled their dues.

School Timings

- 8.45am to 4.15pm Monday to Friday
- 8.45am to 1.00pm Saturday

NOTE: KG students will have holiday on Saturdays.

Fees:

- School fees should be paid during the admission in full or in two instalments (1st instalment on admission day and 2nd instalment before the commencement of SA1 exam)
- The fee paid once will not be refunded.
- The fees prescribed should be remitted at the school office within the date specified.

GUIDELINES TO THE STUDENTS:

- Every Student should wear clean and neat uniform with their identity card at all days of the school as per the guidelines. Personal neatness and cleanliness are essential.

House wise competitions are conducted to build up team spirit and healthy competitive grounds for students. They are divided into 4 houses named as Ramanujan, Abdul Kalam, C N R Rao & R K Narayan.

GENERAL RULES:

1. All students should be present in the school by 8.30am.
2. The official language of the school is English. All the students must speak in English. Students have to be in their respective classes 5 minutes before the beginning of the class.
3. No students are allowed to leave school campus without the permission of the Principal through Class teacher on prescribed record.
4. Attendance in full is expected from the students. 80% attendance is mandatory for appearing examinations.
5. Attendance is compulsory on re-opening and examination days, re-examination will be given only in case of valid health issue reasons with prior permission of principal.
6. Regular tests will be conducted to evaluate the progress of the students. Progress report is issued after each test in open houses. Parents will be requested to attend the open Houses and sign the Report Card.
7. PTA meeting will be conducted once in 3 months to review on students' progress. Parents are advised to attend it without fail for overall support in their children's growth.
8. The students must take prior permission from the PRINCIPAL to attend any Function during class hours. In case of ill health, parents should inform the office on the same day before 10 am.
9. Every student should be regular in studies and in completing their HomeWorks and record books.
10. Students should wear school uniforms, ID, black sandals.
11. School diary should be brought to the school everyday.

12. Bringing 'cell –phones', memory cards, sim cards, pen drive, laptop, smart watches, calculators or any other electronic items to the school premises is strictly prohibited.
13. In case of any damage to the school property or lab equipment, they have to be replaced within fifteen days or should pay the prescribed fine.
14. All students must respect their teachers and non-teaching staff members.
15. All students must maintain silence in the mess hall during lunch.
16. Students should make use of library effectively. They should return the books before the due date to avoid the fine.
17. Sports and entertainments are allowed only in the prescribed school Timings.
18. Do not scribble on the walls of school buildings, desks and tables.
19. Students should not involve in any form of ragging, shouting, howling, whistling etc. within the school premises. If found, necessary actions will be taken against such students.
20. Students should not bring vehicles into the campus.
21. Any kind of misconduct will not be entertained. If found, such student will be punished and debarred from the school for that academic year.
22. Hair and nails should be prone timely. Girls should tie two plaits neatly and tidily with black ribbon.
23. Nail polish or Henna is not allowed. (If there is any close family function, parents should take prior permission from the Principal in written).
24. Boys are not allowed to retain long and stylish hair. Tattoos are strictly banned.
25. All the students should bound to follow the Rules and Regulations of the Institution, failing to which is punishable.

1. The co-operation and goodwill of yours is an essential component of an effective Parents-Teachers relationship in order to provide maximum educational opportunities for children. The school needs the involvement of parents in many of its activities.

3. Parents are expected to duly sign the report cards and look after the progress of their wards. Attending the PTA meeting, open house day as well as other important functions in the school is a duty and a service, parents owe to their children.
4. Parents are requested to check the school diary and take a note of communication from the school.
5. Parents are requested to be co-operative with the school authorities in enforcing regularity and discipline.
6. Pupils should be guided to behave politely and avoid use of indecent language or actions affecting to the feeling of fellow students, teachers or others in the school.
7. Parents should take care to see that, your children attend all the classes, examinations without fail.
8. Every Wednesday and Saturday students are required to wear Track Suits which is provided by the school.
